Navsanjivan shikshan Prasarak Mandal Darwaha Dist. Yavatmal the foundation society of **Jijamata Kala Mahavidyalay Darwaha Dist. Yavatmal** is an organization aimed at the social-cultural development of the region.

Now Chairman of MLL ,Shri Manikraoji Thakare. He is a promising social worker and also a leader of Congress party, an eminent scholar Shri Manikraoji Thakare having great interest in education opened the college named Jijamata Kala Mahavidyalaya, to serve the people of this region. The college is runned on the name of “Jijamata”, the mother of great Maratha Empire Shivaji.

Darwaha is a Tahsil place with a population of near about 40,000. It is situated at a distance of 45 Km South-West to Yavatmal city. It's a small town adjoined with many small villages. The town Darwaha has two senior colleges, seven junior colleges, two D.Ed. colleges, one pharmacy college, one nursing college. The college is financially assisted by the state Govt. and the Central Govt. it is a well managed institution with many outstanding features. At present the college is imparting education in arts faculty with capacity to accommodate 132 students at B.A. part I, II and III each. The total teaching staff is eight full time teachers. (including principal, a librarian) in the administrative staff.
